Enactment of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke Election Law

Presence of Trina C Diabo (Technician on file) and Leslie Skye (Interim Coordinator KLCC). Presentation and explanation of the amendments to the Mohawk Council of Kahnawake Election Law by Trina C Diabo. This was followed by the signing of the MCR recognizing the 'Will of the People' officially passed by 9 of 10 Chiefs in attendance as two were on vacation and Martin Leborgne objected.

Water Connection Agreement Renewal

Presence of Kevin Fleischer (MCK Legal Services). Council authorized the renewal of an agreement between the MCK, Chateauguay and two community members for Chateauguay to maintain a water connection to a local business so that it could continue to operate a fire protection sprinkler system.

Discussions/Updates

- Christine Zachary Deom gave a report on the Health Conference she attended in Quebec City last week.
- Bobby Patton reported on the latest Iroquois Caucus meeting in Tyendinaga.
 With the main issue being the fight against Bill C-10, it was decided the Tobacco
 Industry would take the lead and the Iroquois Caucus would play more of a
 supporting role going forward.
- Martin Leborgne reported to the table that he was approached by a community member about creating a Tenant/Landlord agreement template which could be used as a protection for renters and landlords.
- Kahsennenhawe Sky-Deer updated the table on the next steps in the CDMP for amendments to the *Kahnawà:ke Membership Law*. The KLCC is looking to set a date for the first hearing of the second draft of proposed amendments to the law.
