Other Mohawk Council Executive Directives

• Request for Decision: Appointment of Winona Polson-Lahache to the position of Chief Political Advisor Appointment for three year period to run concurrently with the Council term.

Appointment for three year period to run concurrently with the Council term. Winona Polson-Lahache will replace Mike O'Brien, who chose not to reapply for the position. There will be a two-month transition period. Passed unanimously (see press release dated November 2 for details)

Discussions/Updates

- Discussion on Kahnawà:ke's role in a proposed joint project between Kahnawà:ke and Lachine commemorating Montreal's 375th Anniversary. There are issues that still need to be addressed before any partnership can be formalized
- Discussion of Petition/Complaint signed by 165 community members asking MCK to remove Martin Leborgne from the Tioweró:ton portfolio. While Chief & Council decided that removal was not warranted, Chief Leborgne announced that he will relinquish his role on the Tioweró:ton file effective immediately (see press release date November 3 for details). Lands Portfolio Chiefs Clinton Phillips and Carl Horn will maintain the file until Chief Billy Diabo returns from medical Leave on December 4, 2015
