Request for Decision: Land-based Gaming Project - Phase 2 budget approval

Presence of Ryan Rice, Paul Rice, Joe Delaronde. \$115,000 budget will be allocated from Operational Reserve. Passed 8 to 1, with Carl Horn voting against. Phase 2 will mainly comprise Market Feasibility studies, Economic Impact studies and a technical survey to gauge the level of community support. With passage of today's request Phase 2 will now officially begin.

Request for Decision: Regulations Concerning Raffles

The Kahnawake Gaming Commission has, as a matter of public policy, been given the authority to regulate raffles that have a value of \$1,000 and over.
