Booking your COVID-19 Vaccine via Clic Sante

(Kahnawake – 7, Tsothohrhkó:wa/January 2022) The Kateri Memorial Hospital Centre (KMHC) and Public Safety Commission would like to update Kahnawa'kehró:non regarding technical issues some people have been experiencing when trying to book an appointment for a COVID-19 Vaccine via the Clic Sante portal. Some users may get an error when trying to submit the completed form, which may be the result of not checking off certain medical information, or category you may fall under (see example below).

We will continue to monitor the situation and update the community as required. Clic Sante is operated independently of the KMHC.
