UPDATED – Vaccination Center moves back to the Bingo Hall and new vaccine clinic dates announced

Kahnawake – 10, Tsothohrhkó:wa/January 2022 at 10:00am) The Kateri Memorial Hospital Centre and Public Safety Commission wishes to advise the community that the Vaccination Center will be back at the Bingo Hall on R-138, effective today (Monday) as response to the 5th Wave, and the increased demand for COVID-19 vaccinations. The Bingo Hall site will better serve the needs of the community and provide enough space to safely accommodate those requiring a vaccine.

Additionally, new dates for COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics have been confirmed, with extended hours added for today's (Monday) clinic (in red below):

Booster shots 18 years and older, 1st and 2nd dose for 12 years and older
