Important information - COVID-19 documentation required for travel

(Kahnawake – 25, Enníska/February 2022)

Please be advised that the Local Public Health team at the Kateri Memorial Hospital Centre is unable to provide the COVID-19 documentation required for travel. Travel document requirements vary greatly depending on location and method of travel. It is up to travelers to inform themselves of requirements and to obtain appropriate travel documentation privately.
