## **Low-Cost Spay and Neuter Clinics are back**

**(Kahnawake – 4, Onerahtókha/April 2022)** The Animal Protection Department is pleased to announce that Low-Cost Spay and Neuter Clinics for cats and dogs have resumed.

All services are provided at a significantly reduced rate. There is a maximum of five (5) dog and five (5) cat procedures, each performed on the following dates:

- **Wednesday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, and April 20<sup>th</sup>**
- **Wednesday, May 4<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>**
- **Wednesday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, and 29<sup>th</sup>**

Prices vary according to the weight and sex of the animal. Scheduling an appointment is required - all fees are the responsibility of the pet owner.

Animals will be transported to Timberlea Veterinary Clinic in Kirkland at an additional cost of \$15. Pet owners are asked to provide their cages and carriers.

Please note that there is a waiting list. Also, to address our community's needs, this service is only available to Kahnawa'kehró:non for the time being.
