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Updated Public Health Measures as of April 4th

(Kahnawake – 5, Onerahtókha/April 2022) The Kateri Memorial Hospital Centre Public Health Department and the Public Safety Commission wish to update the community on the current Public Health Measures as per Directive #65 under the Kahnawà:ke *Emergency Preparedness Law*.

An important change has been made to the definition of the term “protected.”

A person is considered **PROTECTED** for **three (3) months** following a prior COVID-19 infection from the onset of symptoms or from the date of a positive test result in the case where there are no symptoms.
