New video features MCK chiefs' positions on casino project, interview with Rama councillor originally a 'no' during his community's referendum

(Kahnawake – 24, Onerahtókha/April 2012) The Kahnawà:ke Casino Project Team is pleased to announce the release of the newest casino project information video presentation. The focus of the final video before the referendum will be on some of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke chiefs and their individual positions on the casino project.

Additionally, there is an interview with Chippewas of Rama councilor Byron Stiles, a former addictions counselor who was originally against a casino in his community but has since become a strong advocate, as he has seen the benefits but none of the problems they were once concerned about.
