Three Chiefs at Iroquois Caucus

(Kahnawá:ke – 10, Onerahtohkó:wa/May 2005) Mohawk Council of Kahnawá:ke (MCK) Chiefs Keith Myiow, Martin Leborgne and Tiorahkwathe Gilbert are scheduled to attend a meeting of the Iroquois Caucus being held at Six Nations on Wednesday and Thursday (11 and 12, Onerahtohkó:wa/May).

This is the third Caucus meeting to be held this year. Agenda items include discussions on tobacco issues, hunting & fishing rights, border crossing & passports and taxation.

The Iroquois Caucus was created as a forum to discuss issues common to the Iroquoian communities. The Caucus first met officially at Tyendinaga in January. Participating or invited communities include Akwesasne, Kahnawá:ke, Kanesatake, Oneida (Ontario), Tyendinaga and Wahta.
