## Reminder – Proposed Residency Law information tomorrow (Tuesday)

(Kahnawake – 15, Onerahtohkó:wa/May 2017) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) wishes to remind Kahnawa'kehrò:non that an information session on the proposed Residency Law is scheduled for tomorrow evening (Tuesday, 16 Onerahtohkó:wa/May) at the Knights of Columbus Hall.

The meeting is the first of three consecutive meetings planned to address the proposal to remove the sections pertaining to residency from the *Kahnawà:ke Membership Law*, with the intent to make it simpler to address and administer that law.

The information meeting will start at 7pm sharp. A meeting to request a community mandate to move forward with the law is scheduled for next Tuesday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>. A third meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, May 30<sup>th</sup>; should a mandate be given, this meeting will be the first to begin the process of developing the draft law.
