## Residency Law Working Group still needs Focus Group members

#### For Immediate Release

(Kahnawake – 17, Onerahtohkó:wa/May 2018) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) wishes to announce that the Working Group responsible for the proposed *Kahnawà:ke Residency Law* is continuing to seek community members interested in participating in a focus group to assist the technical drafting team with the concepts for criteria for portions of the proposed Law.

The Mandate was given by the community in Onerahtohkó:wa/May 2017 to begin drafting a Residency Law. Consensus was reached to move forward, the community directed there be better clarity for the *Eligibility Criteria for Non-Member Residency* portion of the Law.

"The drafting team has identified a need to get some community perspectives on the Eligibility criteria, so we decided to gather a solid focus group to help us consider criteria to propose to the community," said letsénhaienhs Rhonda Kirby, the proponent of the Residency Law. "To be clear, this is <u>not</u> the Community Decision Making Process but, rather, we're looking at this as a tool to prepare a better draft to help when it's time to launch the CDMP meetings."

The focus group session will be held on **Thursday**, **May 24**<sup>th</sup> from 6 to 8pm at the MCK main building.
