



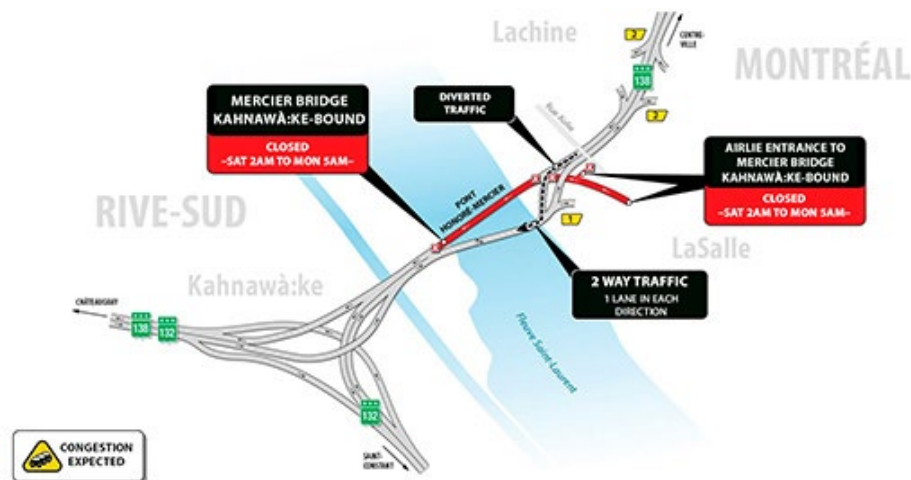
Onkwe'tà:ke lakotokénhstha PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

One lane in each direction this weekend on the Mercier Bridge

(Kahnawà:ke – 26, Onerahtokó:wa/May 2023)

The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) has been informed by the Ministère des Transports du Québec that work to repair the concrete slab will require the closure of the Kahnawà:ke-bound Mercier Bridge from **Saturday 2am until Monday 5pm**.

One (1) lane will be available in each direction (counter-flow traffic configuration) on the Montreal-bound side of the span. The Airlie entrance from Lasalle towards R-138 west/Kahnawà:ke will be closed. See the map below.



Please drive with caution and slow down when entering construction zones, and respect the Move-Over Law when you see flashing lights.

The MCK reminds the public that these works are subject to change due to weather conditions, operational constraints, or work progression and that it does not take part in the scheduling or cancellation of such works.
