(Kahnawake – 28, Onerahtohkó:wa/May 2018) The Kahnawà:ke Legislative Coordinating Commission would like to remind the community that the two remaining sections of the proposed amendments to the *Kanien'kehá:ka of Kahnawà:ke Law* are the agenda items for tomorrow's (Tuesday's) fifth meeting of the Community Decision Making Process Second Hearing.

The agenda will consist of:

- Section 15, Suspension of Entitlements; and
- Section 16, Revocation of Entitlements

The meeting will take place at the **Karonhianóhnha School** gymnasium, from 6 to 8:30pm. Copies of the Draft Law and Records of Discussion for previous meetings are available for review at the KLCC website at <u>www.kahnawakemakingdecisions.com</u>.
