(Kahnawake – 11, Ohiarí:ha/June 2018) The Kahnawà:ke Legislative Coordinating Commission would like to remind the community that the two remaining sections of the proposed amendments to the *Kanien'kehá:ka of Kahnawà:ke Law* are the agenda items for tomorrow's fifth meeting of the Community Decision Making Process Second Hearing.

The meeting will take place at the Karonhianohnha School gymnasium tomorrow (Tuesday, 12 Ohiarí:ha/June 2018) from 6:00pm to 8:30pm.

The agenda will consist of:

- Section 15, Suspension of Entitlements; and
- Section 16, Revocation of Entitlements
