Person tested COVID-19 positive – possible contacts at Matty's Park

(Kahnawake – 16, Ohiarihkó:wa/July 2021)

The Kateri Memorial Hospital Centre (KMHC) Local Public Health Team would like to advise the community that due to the complexity of this outbreak, our team is unable to identify all potential contacts of a recent COVID-19 positive case.

If you or your child was at Matty's Park on **Friday, July 9th between 6:00 PM and 8:30 PM**, we require you to contact the KMHC testing site for testing (450-638-3930 extension 2275 or 2296) and to self-isolate for 14 days (until July 23rd) in order to contain the virus as quickly as possible within our community.

Individuals who have received two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine (and therefore are considered protected) do not have to self-isolate, but must monitor for symptoms and get tested should any COVID-19 symptoms develop.
