Peacekeepers conduct “Back to School” Safety Operation

The Kahnawake Peacekeepers yesterday conducted a traffic safety operation on the Old Chateauguay Road.

The operation started at 06:00hrs and ended at 13:00hrs. During that time, the Kahnawake Peacekeepers stopped 300 vehicles, handed out more than 40 tickets for various infractions including speeding. A majority of those speeding and with the highest recorded speeds were members of the community. A total of 5 vehicles were also seized during the operation.

“With the start of the new school year around the corner, we want to remind both local and non-local motorists that speeding will not be tolerated on our roads”, said Chief Dwayne Zacharie of the Kahnawake Peacekeepers. “We will be conducting more of these operations within the coming weeks and continue throughout the school year”.

The Kahnawake Peacekeepers also checked motorists for seatbelts, proof of insurance, drivers’ licenses and registrations. Non-residents were also reminded that the O.C.R is a limited access road, and only those with permits are allowed access during the morning rush hour.
