## **Low-Cost Spay and Neuter Clinic dates announced for Fall**

**(Kahnawake – 24, Seskehkó:wa/September 2018)** The Animal Protection Department is now scheduling appointments for the next series of Low-Cost Spay and Neuter Clinics for cats and dogs.

All services are provided at a significantly reduced rate but there is a maximum of five (5) dog and cat procedures each performed on the following dates:

- **Wednesday, October 10<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>**
- **Wednesday, November 7<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>**
- **Wednesday, December 5<sup>th</sup>**

Prices vary according to the weight and sex of the animal. Scheduling an appointment and a \$20 deposit is required - all fees are the responsibility of the pet owner.

Animals will be transported to Timberlea Veterinary Clinic in Kirkland at an additional cost of \$15 (\$20 for non-residents). Pet owners are asked to provide their cages and carriers.

Please note that a \$20 annual Kahnawà:ke Animal Protection Membership fee will apply for non-residents. This membership provides access to all clinics throughout the year.
