COVID-19 Visit Risk Calculator

For immediate release

(Kahnawake – 27, Seskehkó:wa/September 2021) The Kateri Memorial Hospital Centre (KMHC) and the Public Safety Commission wish to remind the community that COVID-19 remains an important public health issue in Kahnawà:ke as it continues to spread with the emergence of variants of particular concern. As a result, careful assessment before deciding to visit, gather, or meet with others remains vitally important in the 'new normal.'

Using the best available scientific evidence and the input of leading experts in infectious diseases, public health and epidemiology, a website has been developed by Ryerson University's National Institute on Ageing (NIA) to help people of different ages and states of health better understand the factors that affect the risk of getting COVID-19 when visiting or gathering with others.
