MCK once again offers 'Essential Snow Removal Program'

(Kahnawake – 1, Kenténha/October 2012) The Special Projects Division of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) is pleased to announce that the Essential Snow Removal service for low income elderly and disabled community members will be in operation from December 1, 2012 to March 31, 2013.

The snow removal is intended to provide access to residences for emergency services and includes clearing of the driveway, walkway and steps. The program is accepting a maximum of 65 clients; **previous clientele will need to re-apply for this service**.

Applications forms can be picked up at the MCK main reception beginning today, Monday, October 1st, and submitted no later than **Wednesday, October 31st at 4pm**. No applications will be accepted after this date.

All Kahnawa'kehró:non who are on the Kahnawà:ke Kanien'kehá:ka Registry and who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply for the service:

- A person 65 years of age or older or a person who is physically disabled.
 - The person/couple is someone who lives alone with limited income and has little or no extended family.
 - The person/couple is someone who has a medical problem (either short term or long term).
 - The person/couple is someone who has no family to look out for their wellbeing.
