MCK meets with Quebec Native Affairs Minister Geoffrey Kelley

(Kahnawake – 10, Kenténha/October 2017) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) would like to inform the community that a meeting is being held today with Geoffrey Kelley, the Quebec Minister of Native Affairs.

Agenda items include the stalled Relationship between Kahnawà:ke and the province; the proposed Bill 85 economic development legislation for the A30 and South Shore region; and a discussion on the lack of progress on the remaining (approximately) 200 acres to be returned to Kahnawà:ke as part of the compensation for the completion of A30 project.

Grand Chief Joseph Tokwiro Norton and Ietsénhaienhs Rhonda Kirby, who holds the Intergovernmental Relations portfolio on behalf of the MCK, will be present for the meeting, along with support staff and technicians.

The meeting is taking place in Kahnawà:ke.
