MCK to begin Seigneury dialogue with Community

(Kahnawá:ke – 11, Kenténha/October 2007) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawá:ke (MCK) today announced the start of a major phase of community consultations on the Seigneury of Sault St. Louis.

A group comprised of community members has been selected to begin contacting residents to provide updates on the Seigneury file, listening to comments and concerns, as well as soliciting suggestions and any recommendations they may have on the Seigneury file.

"It's time we begin engaging our community on this important file," said Grand Chief Michael Ahríhrhon Delisle, Jr. "We would like to have the community's involvement and cooperation in an effort to get our people informed on the issues, as well as to provide Council with input as we prepare to embark on the negotiations."

The Seigneury of Sault St. Louis Community Consultation Group (SSSL-CCG) is headed by Trina Skye-Norton. The CCG will be contacting community members starting on October 15, 2007. This phase of community consultation is scheduled to last until the end of February 2008.

The other members of the CCG Team are Melvin T. Diabo, Valerie Delisle, Peter Taylor, and Karlie Goodleaf.
