Holiday Train to Make Third Visit to Kahnawà:ke!

(Kahnawà:ke – 10, Kentenhkó:wa/November 2008) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke would like to inform the community that the famous Canadian Pacific Railway "Holiday Train" will make its third visit to Kahnawà:ke on Wednesday, 26 Kentenhkó:wa/November.

Kahnawà:ke is the first stop for the U.S Holiday Train, which will visit several communities in the north-eastern United States. The various Holiday Trains visit communities across the country (and parts of the U.S.) raising awareness and assisting local food banks. This is the tenth year of operation. Since it began operating in 1999, over \$3.56 million has been raised for this purpose.
