The consultations are being led by the Animal Protection Department and include a survey, both online and in-person, which will take place beginning today (Monday, November 26). In-person Survey Kiosks will be held at the Services Complex from 8:30am to 4pm today and Tuesday, December 4<sup>th</sup>.
