You can secure your spot by booking an appointment for your 3rd vaccine by clicking here. Walk-ins are also welcome, but please note that vaccine quantities are limited.

COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Shot (3rd Dose):

Wednesday, December 15: 12pm to 5pm

• Friday, December 17: 12pm to 5pm

Saturday, December 18: 9am to 12pm

Tuesday, December 21: 9am to 5pm

Wednesday, December 22: 9am to 5pm

*Important Information: It is recommended that anyone under the age of 29 should receive the Pfizer vaccine as a booster/3rd dose, no matter which vaccine they received as their first or second dose, to reduce the risk of myocarditis and pericarditis.

With the number of confirmed COVID-19 variant (Delta and Omicron) cases on the rise around the world, it is recommended to get your booster or 3rd dose to enhance vaccine efficacy.

We would also like to remind Kahnawa'kehró:non that anybody requiring a vaccine after, December 22 at 5pm, to book an appointment via the ClincSante website, as our Vaccination Clinic will be closed for the holiday period.
