### KFB says 'stay fire-free this holiday season'

(Kahnawake - 17, Tsothóhrha/December 2018)

The Public Safety Unit of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke and the Kahnawake Fire Brigade want you to have a safe holiday season. The following are some tips for **Christmas Tree Fire Prevention**:

- Cut 5 cm from the trunk before placing it in the stand.
- Water the tree every day.
- Ensure lights are safe to use and are for indoor use only.
- Place tree away from heat sources (candles, fireplace, wood stoves, heaters
- Turn lights off before bed or when leaving your home
- Don't overload the light sockets (no more than three strands plugged into each other)
- Take your tree down within four weeks of putting it up
- Ensure your smoke alarms are working
