TOXIC

Steps for good storage/ Management

#1

- Read labels
- Do not mix products
- Wash your hands after handling

#2

- Keep containers sealed
- Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat sources
- Keep out of reach of children and animals

#3

- Keep products in original containers or clearly identify their contents
- Bring products to the *Transfer Depot*

What is accepted as Special Collections?

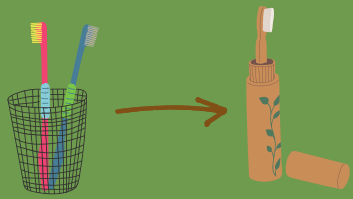
- Refundable Cans and Bottles

- Used Batteries



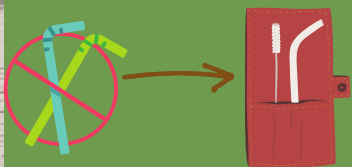

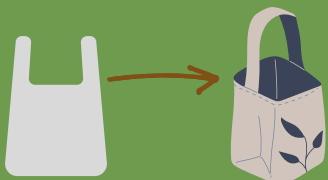
Low Waste Swaps
