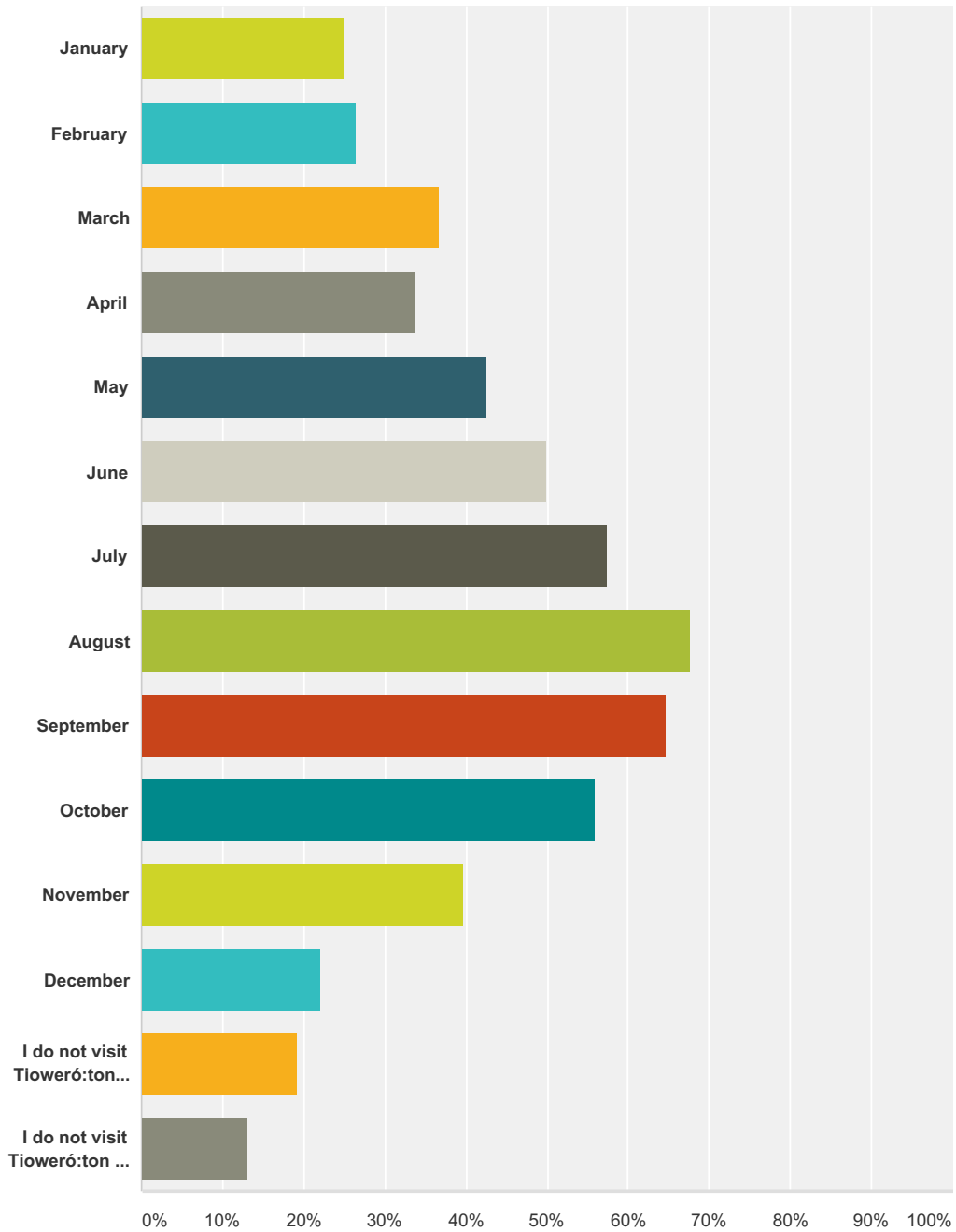


Q1 Which months do you visit Tioweró:ton? Check all that apply

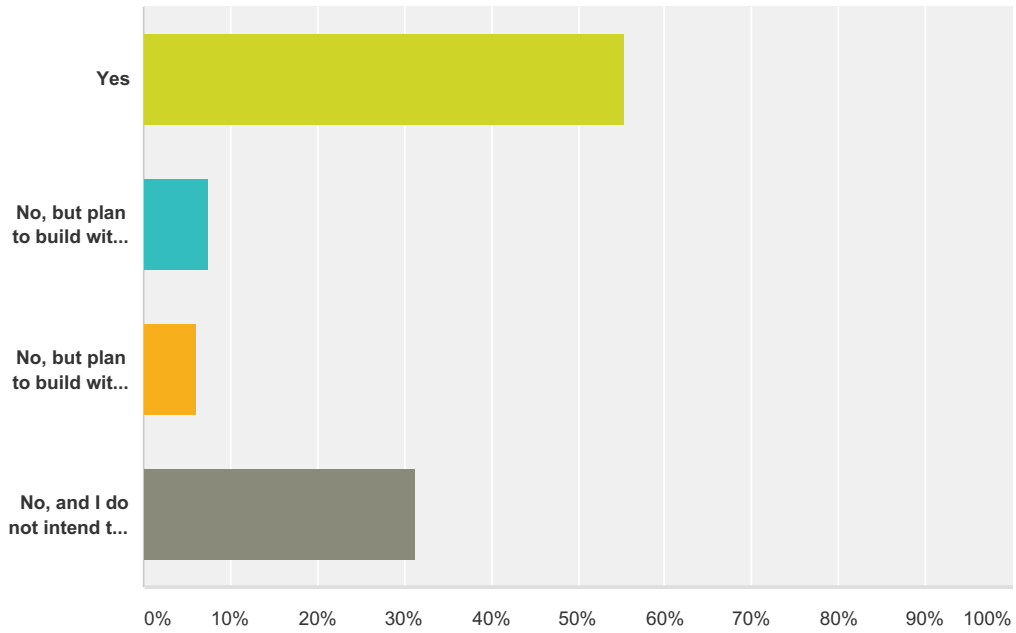

Q2 Do you have a cabin in Tioweró:ton?

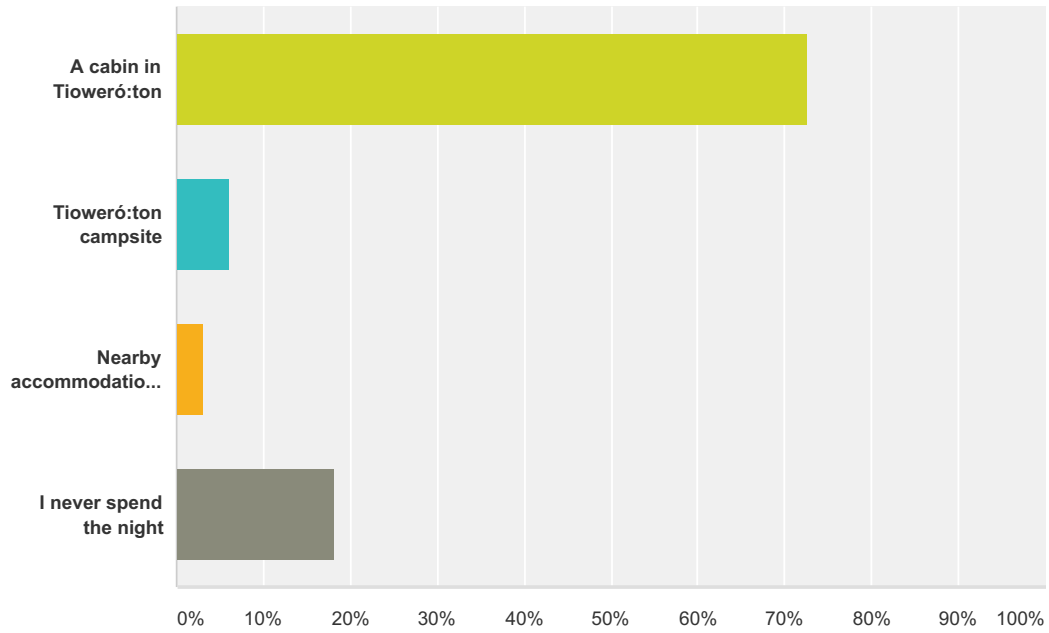

Q3 Where do you stay when you visit Tioweró:ton?

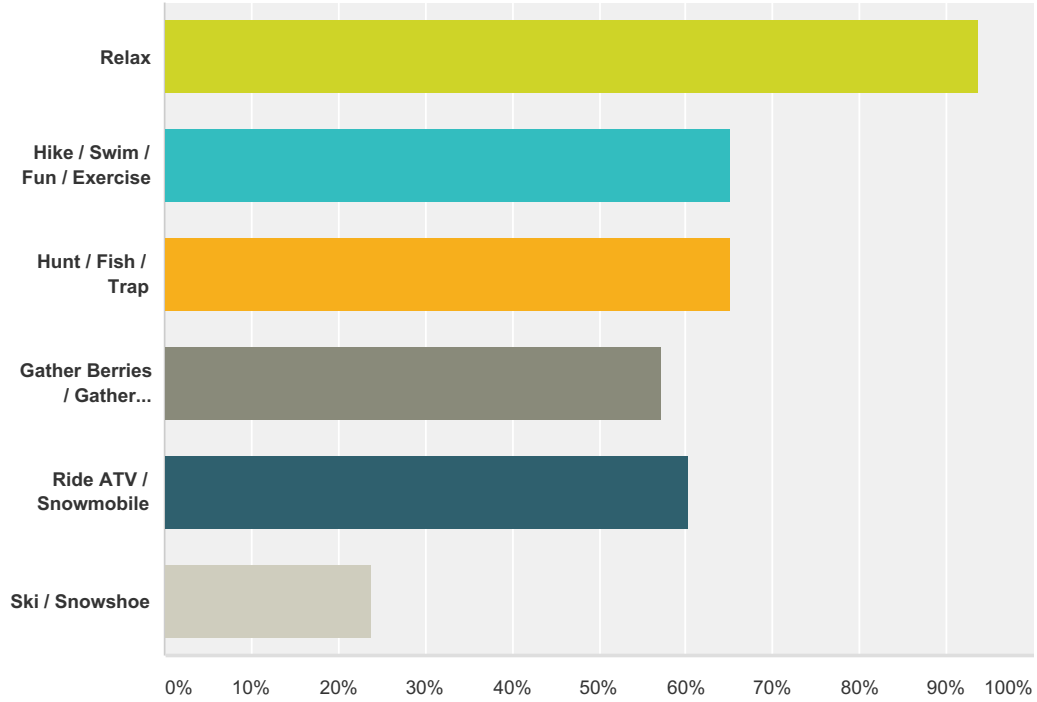

Check all that apply**

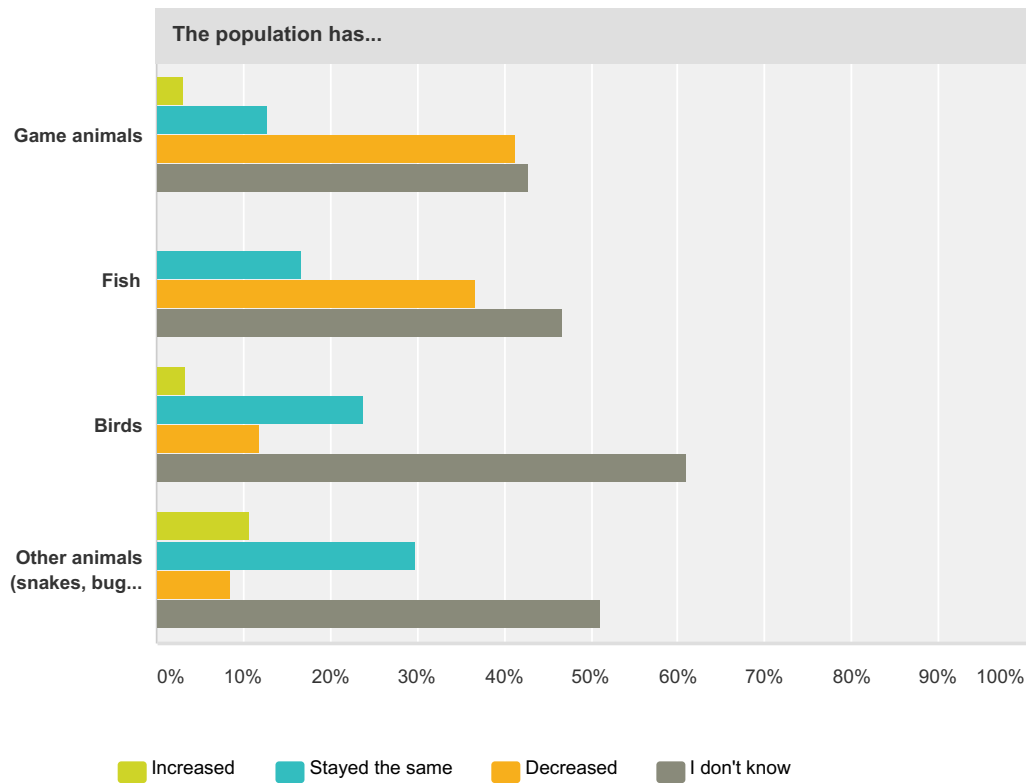

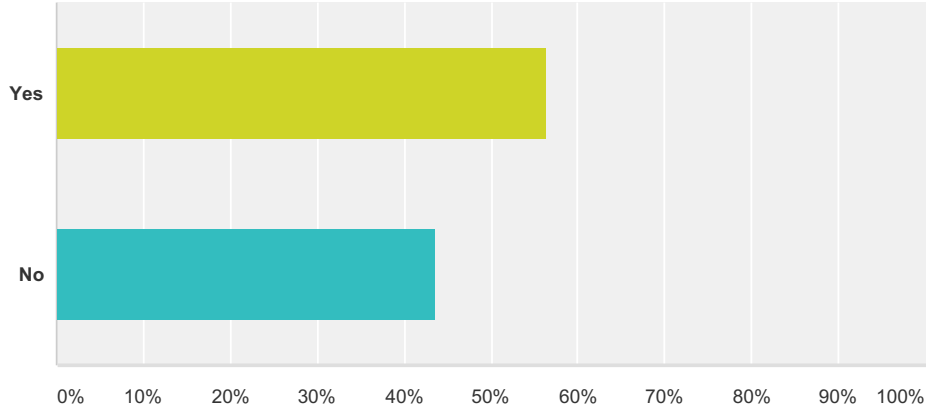

Q6 Would you be willing to participate in a monitoring program concerning hunted species / fish and medicines?

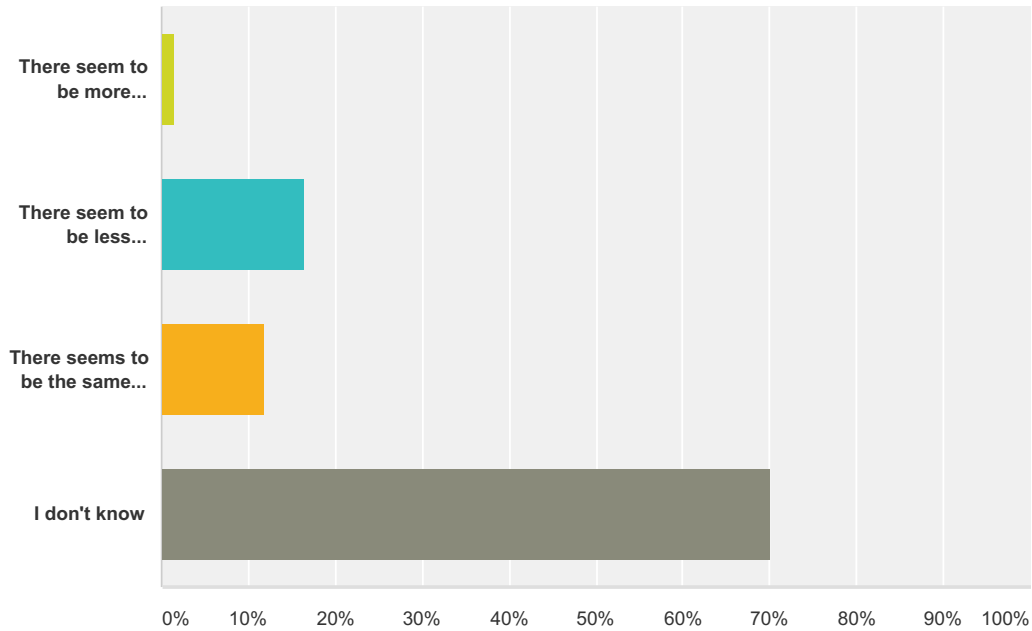

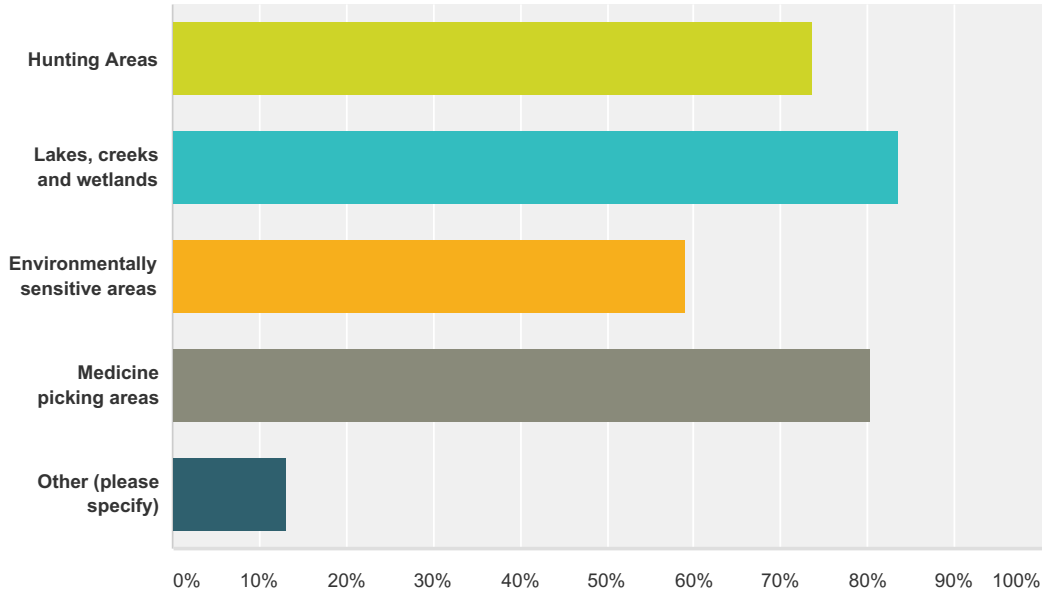

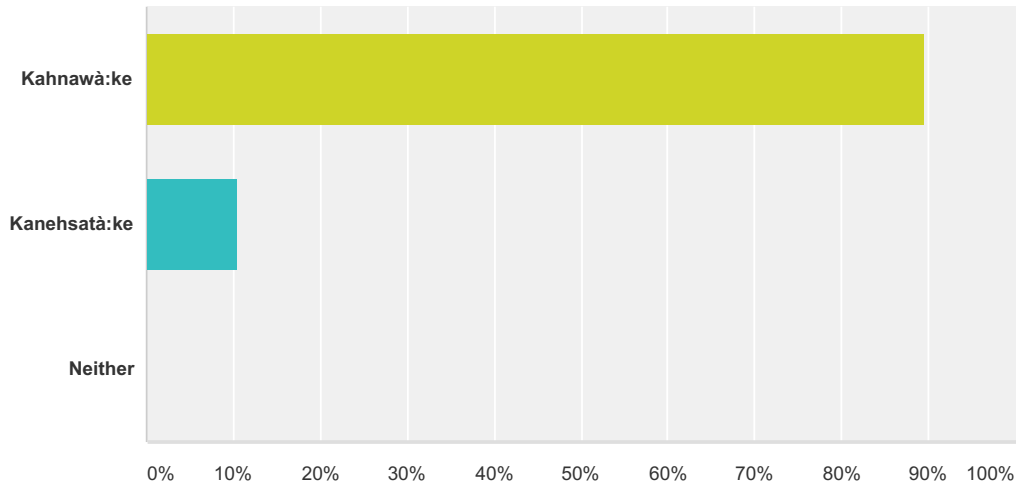
