



MCK seeks Cannabis Control Board Members

The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke would like to inform Kahnawa'kehró:non that they are seeking more applications from interested individuals to serve on the Cannabis Control Board.

The *Kahnawake Cannabis Control Law* requires that a regulatory body be established, which will be known as the Cannabis Control Board. The purpose of the Board will be to regulate, enforce and administer this Law.

A board member's term of office will be not less than two (2) years and not more than (3) years. Board members are expected to prepare for, attend and conscientiously participate in all Board meetings. Members will receive an honorarium.

Pursuant to the Law, to be eligible to be selected and appointed to the Board, a person must:

- a) be a Kanien'kehá:ka of Kahnawà:ke;(b) have attained the full age of twenty-one (21) years old;
- b) be resident within the Territory;
- c) not have an interest in a private entity that has applied for or has been granted a license;
- d) not have a family member that has an interest in a private entity that has applied for or has been granted a license;
- e) have no criminal conviction for an indictable offence or have received a full pardon for any such conviction.
- f) sign a confidentiality agreement and a privacy waiver;
- g) have no criminal conviction for an indictable offence or have received a full pardon for any such conviction. Applicants will undergo a background check.;

Experience with regulatory matters or participating on boards and commissions is an asset. Due to the complex and challenging nature of the tasks related to this position, applicants must be willing to participate in training and must be capable of learning and applying basic concepts of administrative law. Applicants must demonstrate strong writing skills as well as the ability to make sound decisions based on the Law and Regulations.

Interested persons are asked to submit a letter of intent to at the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke, P.O. Box: 720, Kahnawà:ke Mohawk Territory, J0L 1B0. Letters of intent can also be dropped off at the main reception of the Mohawk Council office.

The deadline for applying is **Friday, May 24, 2019**.
