MCK to conduct surveys on Public Meetings, Commuter Train Stop at Adirondack Junction

For immediate release

(Kahnawá:ke – 13, Enníska/February 2007) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawá:ke (MCK) announced that it will conduct a pair of surveys. One will be to determine whether there is support for a railroad stop at the Adirondack Junction, while the second will be to gauge public opinion on the frequency of Community meetings.

A commuter train from Delson to the island of Montreal has been in operation for the past couple of years but currently does not stop in Kahnawá:ke. In the past, commuter trains used to stop at Adirondack Junction when the service was operated by Canadian Pacific. However, the service ended in the late 1970's.

Upcoming major repair work on Mercier Bridge is expected to cause massive traffic delays, therefore the idea of a local stop is once again being considered.

The surveys will be conducted together from Thursday and Friday, 1 and 2 Enniskó:wa/ March at the Services Complex. On-line and telephone surveys will also be utilized.
