# Peacekeepers Ethics Committee seeking community member

**(Kahnawake – 9, Enniskó:wa/March 2022)** The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) wishes to inform the community that it is looking for one (1) person to serve on the Kahnawà:ke Peacekeepers Ethics Committee.

As stated in its mandate, the Peacekeeper Ethics Committee will, "consider complaints made by any person against one or more members of the Kahnawà:ke Peacekeepers and to resolve those complaints using principles and processes set out in the Kahnawà:ke Peacekeepers Law, and any regulations derived from the Law."

Interested Kanien'kehá:ka of Kahnawà:ke must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age and reside within the Territory. All candidates will be required to sign a waiver to permit a criminal background check. The members will be selected by the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke based on written nominations/recommendations sent to the address below no later than 4pm on Friday, April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022:

The selected member will be required to meet on a monthly basis, as well as attend other meetings and activities that may be necessary to fulfill their mandate.
