(Kahnawake – 19, Enniskó:wa/March 2021) As per section 5.3 of the *Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke Election Law*, the Kahnawà:ke Justice Commission is inviting interested persons to submit their candidacies for the position of Electoral Officer for the 2021 Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) Elections. The submission period begins on Friday 19, Enniskó:wa/March, and ends at 4pm on Tuesday 6, Onerahtókha/April.

Candidates must sign a privacy waiver to allow verification that they meet the following eligibility requirements:

- over the age of twenty-one (21) years;
- meet the requirements of the Kahnawà:ke Membership Law (Kanien'kehá:ka of Kahnawà:ke Law) and be listed as a member (recognized) on the Kahnawà:ke Kanien'kehá:ka Registry and not currently have their benefits and entitlements as a member suspended;
- ordinarily resident in Kahnawà:ke;
- not have been convicted and sentenced for a criminal offense within the previous six (6) years. A six (6) year ban commences only after the sentence has been served in full;
- not a member of the Council at any time during the year immediately preceding the election or intends to be a candidate in the election.

The Electoral Officer must also meet the requirements contained in the <u>Terms of Reference</u> and have the skills and experience necessary to conduct the 2021 MCK Elections in a fair, transparent, and accountable manner. To assist with the evaluation, Candidates must also provide:

- a completed application form;
- a letter of intent and resume;
- two (2) professional letters of reference; and
- proof of minimum high school education.

Candidates deemed by the Kahnawà:ke Justice Commission to meet minimum requirements and to have the necessary skills and experience necessary after a verification and screening process will be placed on the ballot for a community vote.
