## **Low Cost Spay and Neuter Clinic dates announced**

**(Kahnawake – 22, Enniskó:wa/March 2017)** The Animal Protection Department of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke is now scheduling appointments for the next series of Low-Cost Spay and Neuter Clinics for cats and dogs.

A maximum of 5 dog and 5 cat procedures will be performed each day on the following dates:

- **Wednesday, April 12<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>**
- **Wednesday, May 10<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>**
- **Wednesday, June 7<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>**

All services are provided at a significantly reduced rate but prices vary according to the weight and sex of the animal. Scheduling an appointment and a \$20 deposit is required - all fees are the responsibility of the pet owner.

Animals will be transported to Timberlea Veterinary Clinic in Kirkland at an additional cost of \$15 (\$20 for non-residents). Pet owners are asked to provide their own cages and carriers.

Please note that a \$20 annual Kahnawà:ke Animal Protection Membership fee will apply for non-residents. This membership provides access to all clinics throughout the year.
