MCK rejects Biological Control of Mosquitoes

For immediate release

(Kahnawá:ke – 24, Enniskó:wa/March 2006) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawá:ke (MCK) decided against accepting the proposal for the application of the mosquito control agent BTI (*bacillus thuringiensis israelensis*) in the Territory.

The City of Chateauguay had approached the MCK for permission to apply BTI in the outlying areas of the community to help control the mosquito population in Chateauguay. The application had taken place last year.

The Council Chiefs based their decision on presentations by the Kahnawá:ke Environment Office, the Kahnawá:ke Environmental Health Office, and a group of local environmentalists.

The Mayor of Chateauguay, Sergio Pavone, was also present, along with representatives of GDG Environment Ltd.
