More Walk-ins accepted Thursday for Vaccinations

(Kahnawake – 24, Enniskó:wa/March 2021) The Kahnawà:ke COVID-19 Task Force wishes to inform Kahnawà:ke that additional walk-ins will be accepted at the Mass Vaccination Center tomorrow, Thursday, March 25th, from **10:30am until 3:30pm**. Appointments will not be required for this time period.

Only residents of Kahnawà:ke can present themselves at the Mohawk Bingo Hall on Route 138 beginning at 10:30am. Non-residents will be turned away. All safety protocols will be in place, including masks (provided), distancing, and hygiene.

The walk-ins are ONLY for those who are getting vaccinated for their first dose. For those who have already booked an appointment for Thursday, they will be respected.
