The Kahnawà:ke Environment Protection Office (KEPO) would like to invite the community to a screening of the short film Entewahnekahserón:ni We are Rejuvenating the Waters, hosted at Kanien'kehá:ka Onkwawén:na Raotitióhkwa Language and Cultural Center (KOR) on Wednesday, April 10, starting at 6pm for Cultural Awareness Month.

Collected as part of the North Creek Community Visioning Project, the film is a compilation of elder stories, memories, and visions for the future of North Creek and Kahnawà:ke. KEPO staff will be in attendance to answer questions about the Entewahnekahserón:ni project.

A private daytime screening will be held for participants and their families at the Turtle Bay Elders Lodge before the evening screening at KOR.
