Kahnawake Waste Management to conduct Public Consultation

For immediate release

(Kahnawake – 7, Onerahtókha/April 2022) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke is inviting Kahnawa'kehró:non to participate in a Public Consultation of a draft Seven-Year Waste Management Plan ("the Plan").

The Consultation will be overseen by a committee composed of representatives from different sectors of the community to ensure all the information necessary for the Draft Plan is provided. The committee will collect feedback from community members, groups and organizations on the subject.

"This new plan sets the path forward for our continued efforts towards improving how we manage waste generated by our community," said Manager of the Waste Management Department Holly McComber. " Collected data from 2020-2021 shows us that Kahnawà:ke generated 2,493 metric tons of waste and 857 tons of blue bin recyclable materials. Moving forward, we are hopeful to find more ways to reduce, divert and manage waste more effectively."
