Chiefs to meet on Border Crossing Identification issue

For immediate release

(Kahnawá:ke – 19, Onerahtókha/April 2006) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawá:ke (MCK) has announced that Chiefs Mike Bush and Martin Leborgne will be in Tyendinaga tomorrow (20 Onerahtókha/April) for a meeting on the issue of Border Crossing Identification. This meeting is, in fact, a planning session for the upcoming Iroquois Caucus scheduled for next month in Six Nations.

There is growing concern among the Caucus members about the need to implement our own form of ID cards before the United States' deadline of Tsothóhrha/December 2007. After that date people entering the U.S. will be required to use either U.S. or Canadian identification (passports).

With that in mind, it is expected that the agenda for the next Caucus will focus exclusively on this topic.
