(Kahnawake – 25, Ohiarihkó:wa/July 2019) The Mohrwi Council of Kahnawà:ke would like to advise the community that it will be priviled with the Ministère des Transport du Crebés (M. Q.) de la upcoming study for the new Morsie and a White.

The Kahnawà:ke Environment Protection Office (KEPO) had expressed concerns about potential environmental impacts of the drilling and insisted on a study to assess the fish habitat and sturgeon spawning ground adjacent to the bridge. The fieldwork for this study took place in the spring. KEPO's role in this project is to ensure that all aspects of our community's environmental concerns are protected throughout this project and KEPO will have a presence on the barge at all times to monitor the study/drilling.

Chief and Council would also like to reassure the community that it is working with all parties involved in this project to protect our land, rights, and interests.
