(Kahnawake – 28, Seskéha/August 2019)

The Kahnawà:ke Environment Protection Office (KEPO) of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (MCK) is seeking community participation in the Enhanced Maritime Situational Awareness (EMSA) pilot project.

EMSA is a web-based mapping system that provides a wide variety of information focused on the marine environment. The MCK is looking to use the system to improve access to the North Wall, protect the environment, and improve public safety. The system has applications for community members who regularly use the waterways or are involved in geographic research.
