MCK protests comments in House of Commons debate

(Kahnawá:ke – 28, Seskehkó:wa/September 2005) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawá:ke (MCK) is upset with comments made in the House of Commons on Monday (26, Seskehkó:wa/September) by Keith Martin (L), the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of National Defense, essentially alleging that Kahnawá:ke and Kanesatake are havens for crime.

The MCK has sent a letter protesting the comments and asking for a retraction to set the record straight: Kahnawá:ke is <u>not</u> open for criminals. Further, the letter clarifies Kahnawá:ke's difficulties in dealing with Canada's ineffective delivery system of Federal tobacco permits.

"I also wish to state that I'm tired of the government always assuming that Kahnawá:ke is one and the same as other communities, Mohawk or otherwise," said Grand Chief Michael Ahríhron Delisle, Jr., "and, as the letter states, I strongly suggest that Mr. Martin and his colleagues speak to us directly. Our doors are open to meet at any time."
